The mic testing quartet will work with the judge and sound operator from 11:30 -12.

The chorus and quartet will be transported back to the hotel at 12:00 noon.

On contest day, the Pan Pacific-Aires will warm-up at the hotel and be transported to the theatre and be the first chorus on stage for the sound check.
